Registration is based on first come first served. These tours can sell out early, so we strongly suggest you register early to reserve your space.

Registration deposit: To reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250 per person** registration deposit. You may cancel with a total refund on all deposits, except \$50 per person admin fee up to **February 1, 2018**. If you wish to use your credit card, give us a call.

After February 1, 2018 – Second payment of \$3,000 total per person is due: \$1,500 per person is nonrefundable until **June 1, 2018**. We will be purchasing your airfare at this time.

After June 1, 2018 - Final payment due: Total tour cost - 100% non-refundable. Cancellation & medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. **Private single rooms** are available for an additional **\$400 per person**.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after **Feb 1, 2018** to protect 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans by going to travelguard.com or we would be happy to give you a quote for this protection. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to **Crisp Tours** in anyway.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European tours, we can't be beat. The major risk factor in pricing your trip in dollars based on the cost of the Euro. In the unlikely event the Euro increases higher than what we predicted, we could show a loss. Therefore, for every .01 increase above 1.35 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.37 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early**. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the US dollar.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed in brochure, ground transportation due to missed flights or when doing own air, flight upgrades, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, two dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Tour Extensions: If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know before **February 1, 2018**. We can usually make these arrangements at little or no extra cost to you.

Land Package Only: If you make your own air arrangements, upgrade to Business or 1st Class, subtract **\$900 per person**. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport or at the hotel in Grassau. If you are unable to meet the bus because of your schedule, we may be able to arrange transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. As a recording artist, his voice can be heard on the Alliance, Blue Star, Chinook, DJ, Dance Ranch, Hi-Hat & Silver Sounds labels, as well as many CD's and cassettes. Joe is also a member of SAG, and he choreographed and appeared in a made-for-TV movie, "Blue Skies". Joe and Chris married in 1982 and spend November - April running a full square dance program in Pharr, TX. The remaining months they maintain a smaller program there, tour and travel domestically & internationally to call at festivals & special dances. Joe enjoys what he calls his vocation and avocation, and feels fortunate to be part of this great activity.

Tom started calling in 1968 while stationed in Germany and has been active ever since.
